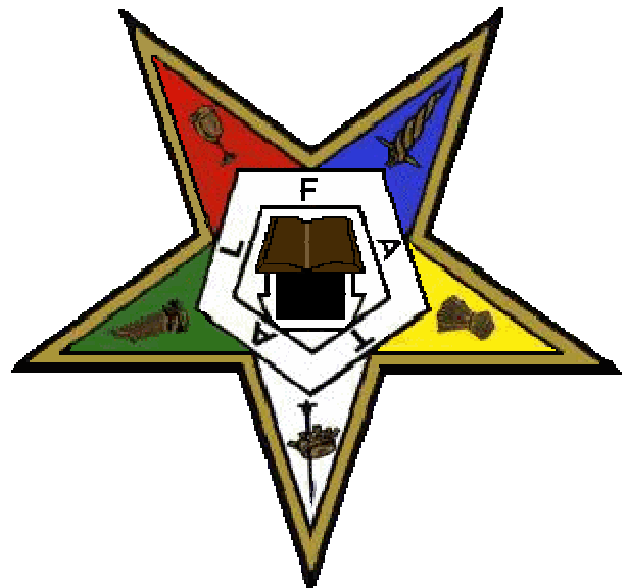

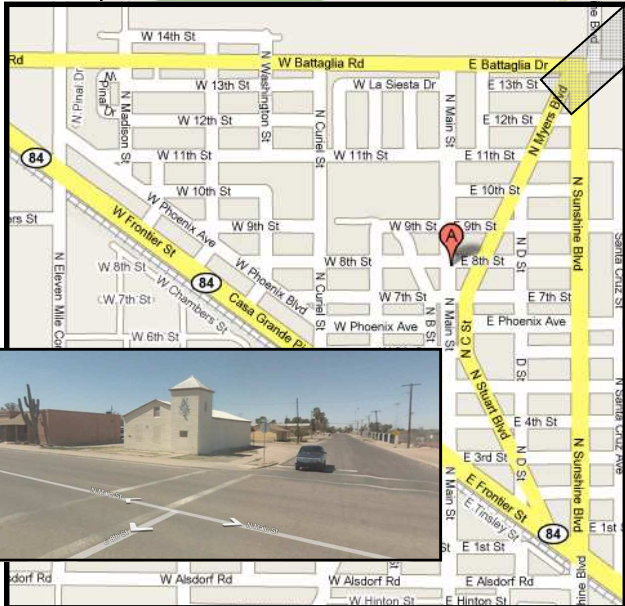
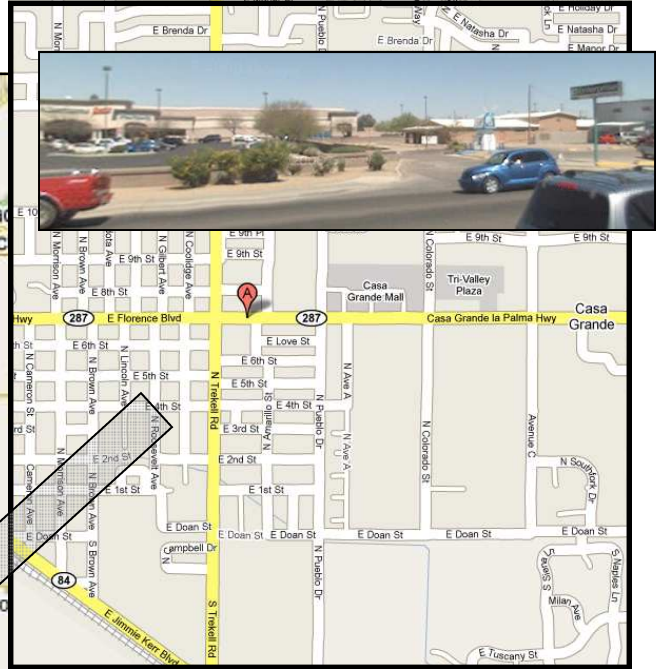

**G**reetings Brothers,

There isn't a whole lot to write about this month, so there is a little something different here than usual.

We still have a lot of work to do on the Lodge building to finish getting ready to paint, and to get it painted. We have scheduled a work party for Saturday, June 12th at 7am. All of you who live close enough and are able to help out, your presence will be greatly appreciated. Besides finishing up the preparation of the outside of the building, we need to get the entry/kitchen area cleaned up and straightened up. The grass and weeds are getting out of hand and we need to do some weed whacking and get some weed killer sprayed before the city does it for us and charges us for their effort.

We have two prospective candidates coming along if everything goes as it should. We cannot give any dates for degrees yet.

For those of you who would like to improve your knowledge of Masonry and its history, we have a set of fifteen books published by the Masonic Service Association. Each one is of a different title. The books are not large, only about four by six inches, and from about one quarter to one half inch thick, so they will be an easy read. The copyright date in them is 1924, so they are 86 years old.

We also have two Large notebooks of the "Short Talk" pamphlets that cover many, many Masonic topics such as famous Masons, origins of some of our words, and rituals, Masonic History and research topics among many others. These pamphlets are also published by the Masonic Service Association. There is a very large collection of Arizona Grand Lodge proceedings going back as far as 1932, perhaps further. Any of the above can be checked out for your perusal and or discussion. All we ask is that you return what you borrow. We did have the book on Masonry that was written by Brother Albert Pike. It has disappeared. If anyone borrowed it, please return it to the Lodge so that others may have access to it.

We have just received a new listing from Heirloom Bible Publishers. They have Masonic Bibles available (four different editions) ranging in price from \$19.25 to \$36.20 each. If you are interested in purchasing one for yourself or another Brother Mason, please see the Lodge Secretary.

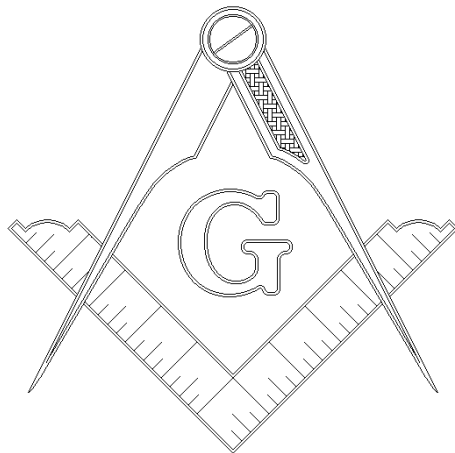
