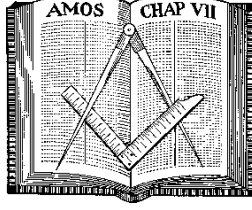

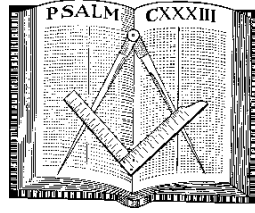

Electronic Trestle Board

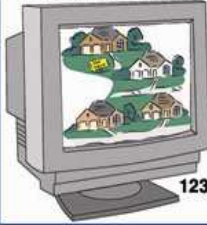

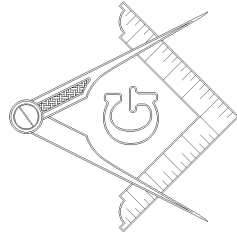
